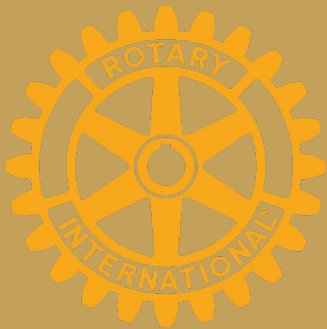

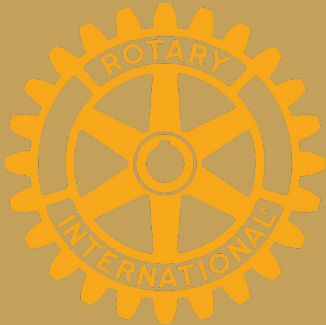

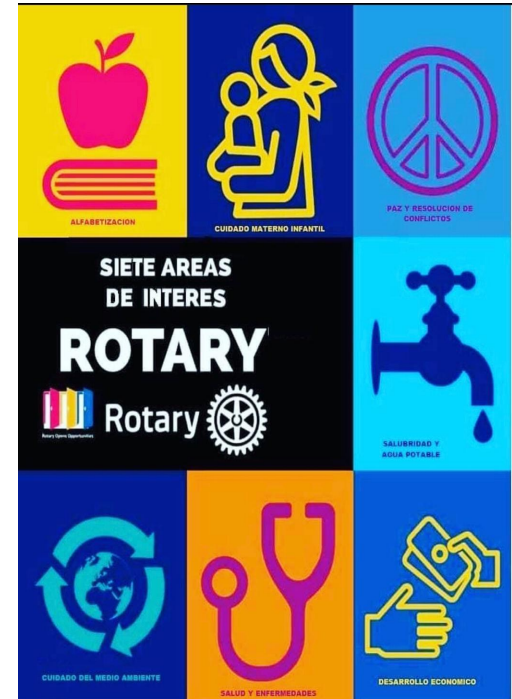


Global grants help fund

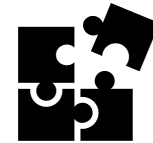


NUTS & BOLTS – Global Grants

Minimum requirements to apply

- Clubs must be qualified by the District
- MINIMUM Project budget = \$30k
- Clubs & Districts contribute \$\$; RI World Fund matches District (DDF) at 80%
- Online application www.rotary.org

NUTS & BOLTS cont'd



- **Application emphasizes**
 - **Community assessment**
 - **Sustainability**
 - **Measurable outcomes**
 - **Active involvement of Rotarians in project**

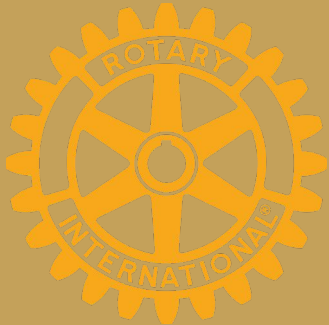

- **Submit Global Grant Proposal Form to District (online)**
- **Apply to RI online; upload documents**
- **Expect 3-6 month application / approval**

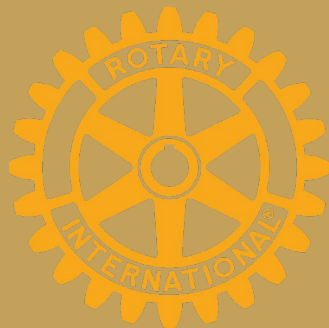
